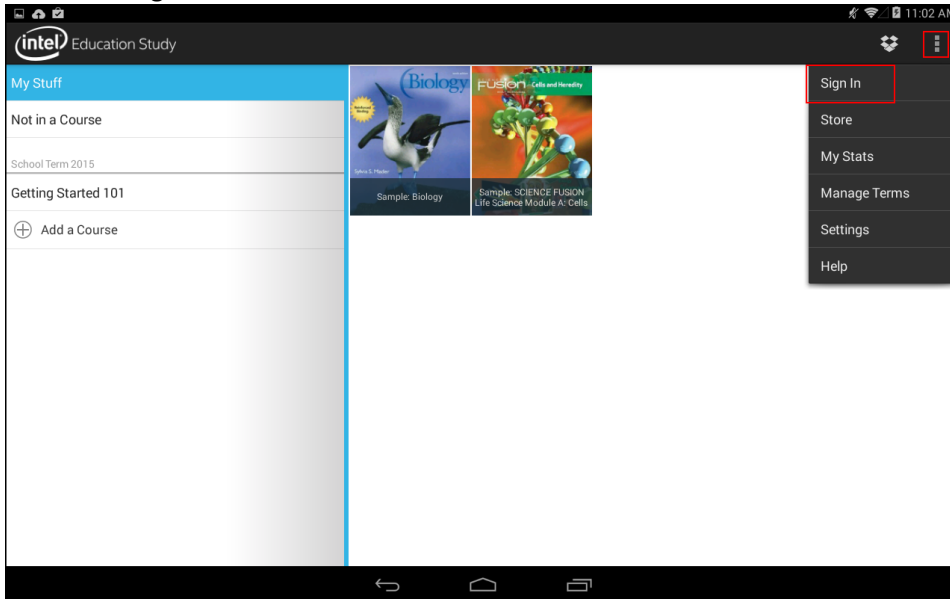


BYOD – Using Intel® Education Study on Your Android Device

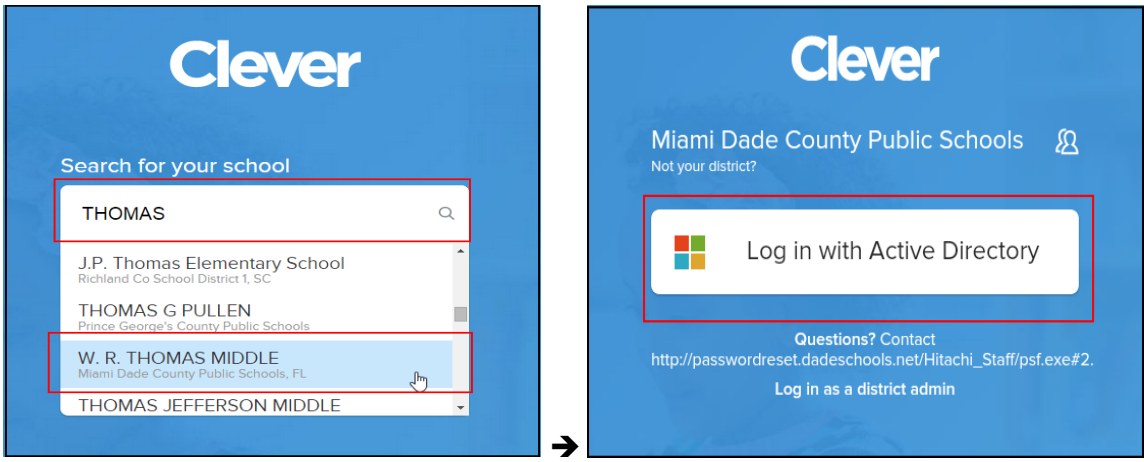
1. If not already installed, install the Intel® Education Study App from the Google Play Store
 - a. Link: <https://play.google.com/store/apps/details?id=com.kno.textbooks&hl=en>
2. After installing the app, open the app on the device
3. Select the Sign In button



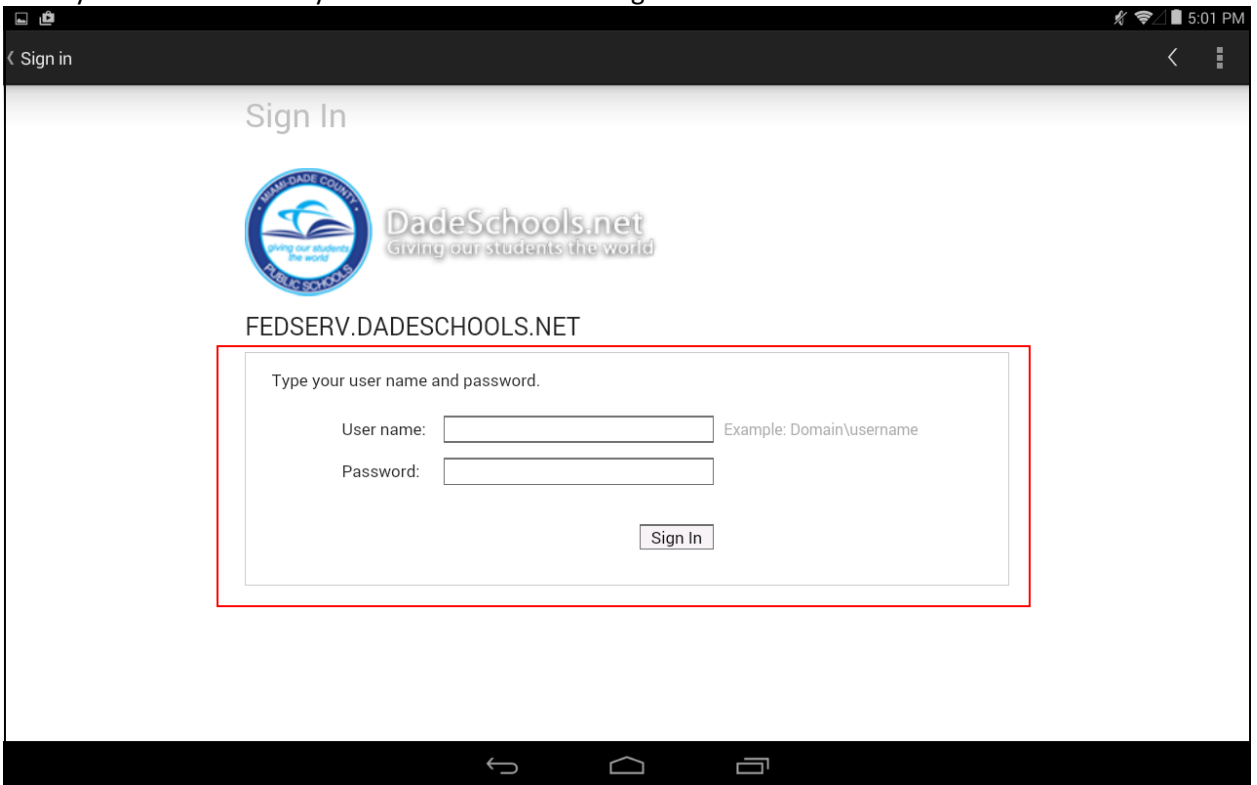
4. On the sign in page, select “Sign in with Clever”

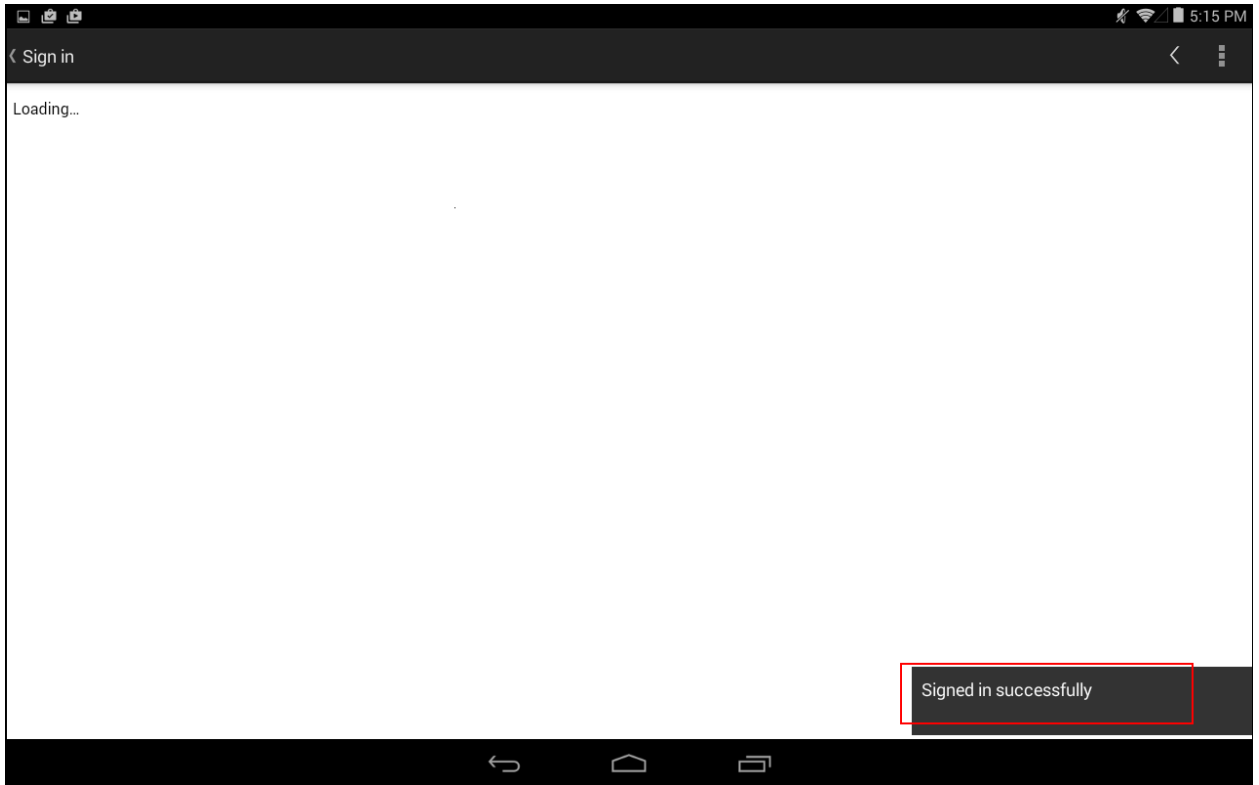
5. On the Clever Instant Login page, search the name of your school
 - a. Once the institution is found, select it
 - b. After selecting your school, select “Log in with Active Directory”



6. Enter your Active Directory credentials and select “Sign In”



7. After entering your AD credentials, you will be taken back to the Course Manager and should see a confirmation message stating “Signed in successfully”.



8. From there, the eTextbooks associated with your account will begin to populate within your Course Manager with "Tap to Download" displayed across the cover
