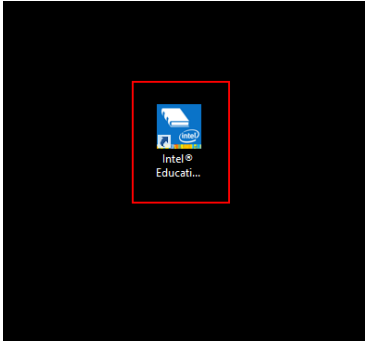


BYOD – Using Intel® Education Study on Your Personal Windows Device

Note: Please be sure your device meets the minimum specifications as listed on the MDCPS Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) page - http://wifi.dadeschools.net/minimum_specs.asp

Step 1: If not already installed, install the Intel® Education Study App from the Intel® Download Center

- a. Link: <https://downloadcenter.intel.com/download/24953>
- b. After installing the app, open the app on the device



Step 2: Keep the app open in the background, and navigate to the Miami Dade County Public Schools Portal on your device (<http://www.dadeschools.net/students.asp>). Click the button “Login to the Student Portal.”


Step 5: Select the Intel® Education Study App for Windows Desk

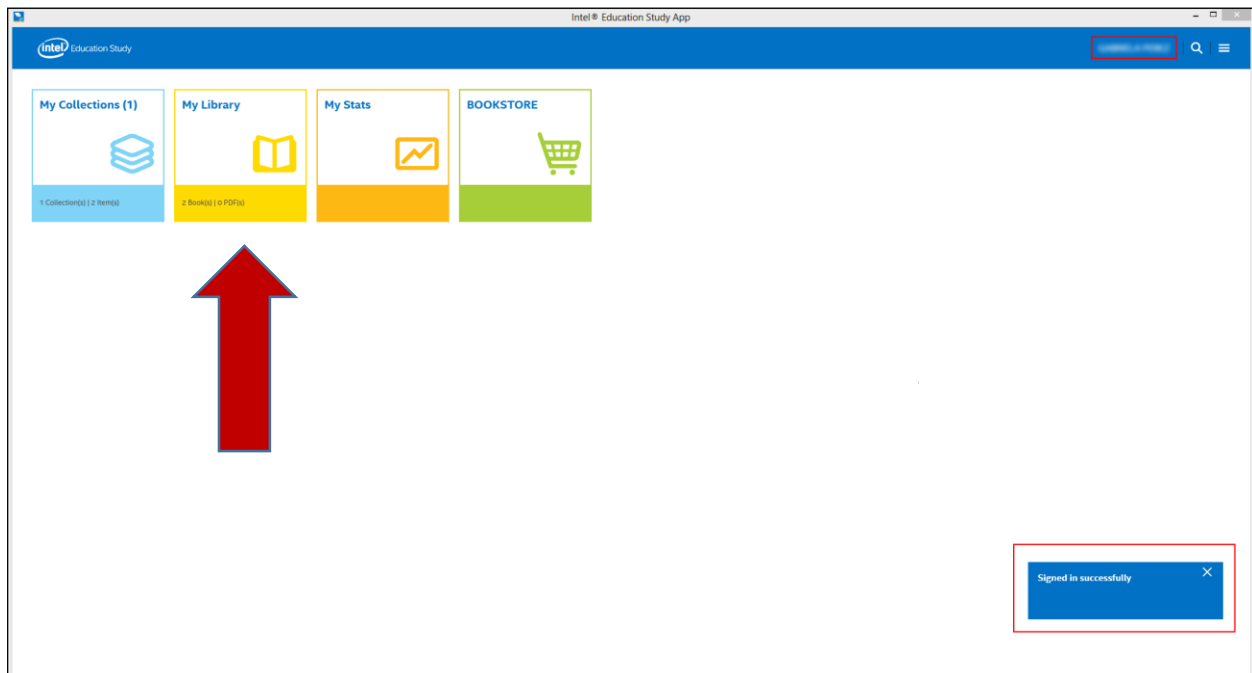

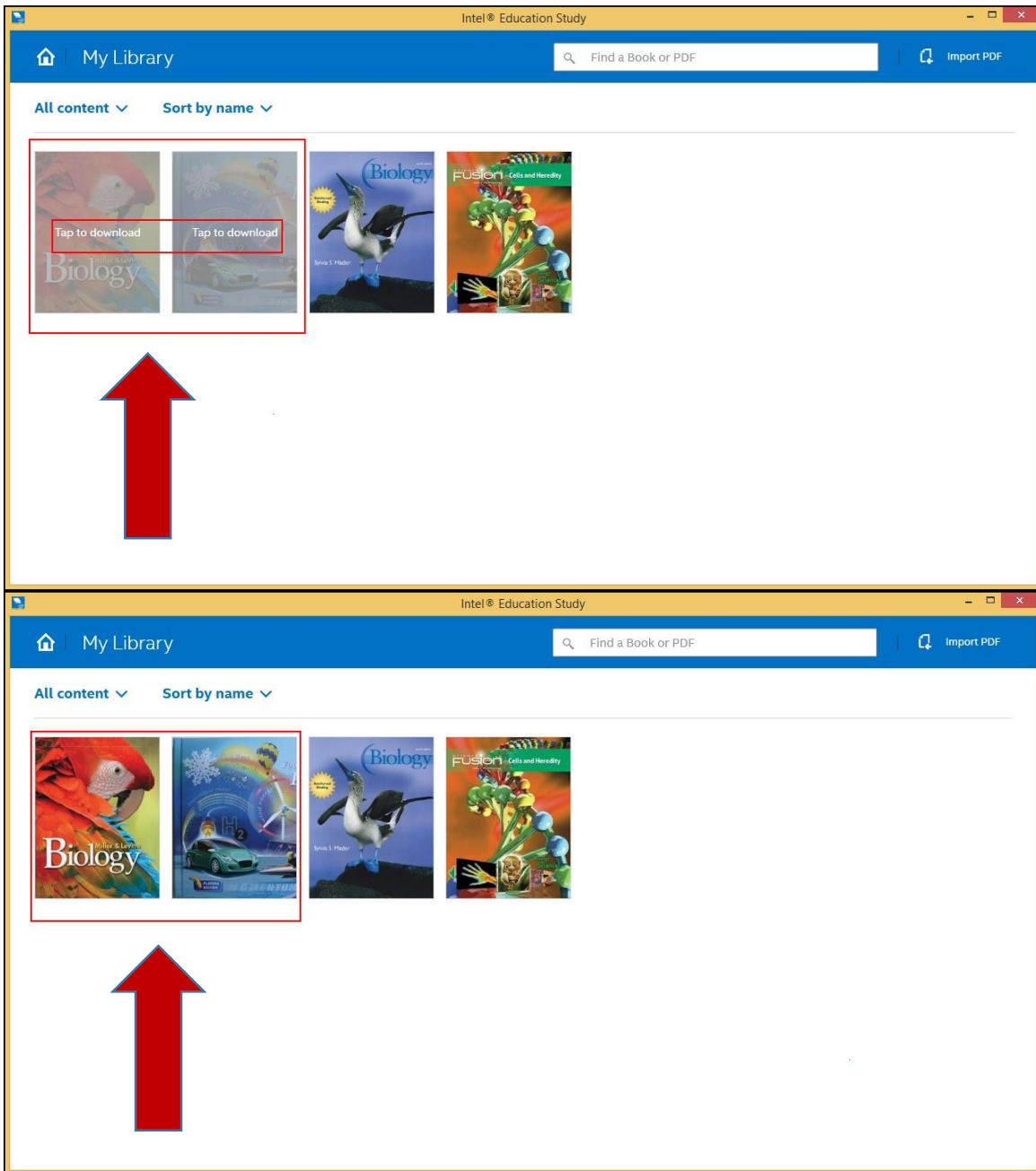
Step 7: Land in the Intel® Study app and open “My library”.

- a. The sign in process will take place within a few minutes and your eTextbooks will begin to populate within your account under “My Library”.



Step 8: Access your books.

- a. The eTextbooks associated with your account will begin to populate within “My Library” with “Tap to Download” displayed across the cover. Give the process a few minutes to collect all eTextbooks associated with account.
- b. When completed, the eTextbooks will show under “My Library” with “Tap to download” over the cover. Click “tap to download” on each book and give the system a few minutes to download the eTextbooks directly to the device. You will receive a notification when each download is completed and the eTextbook cover will appear bright/vivid.
 - a. Note: During the download process, be sure to:
 - i. Stay connected to the internet
 - ii. Keep the Study App open
 - iii. Keep the device awake and powered on



Step 9: Future access. Just Click on the Intel® Education Study application on the desktop. 😊

- a. After Steps 1-3 have been completed at the beginning of the school year, the application can be launched without needing to go through the Miami-Dade portal. Just click on the Intel® Study application icon on the device, and you will be fully signed in with all downloaded eTextbooks.
- b. You can also launch the app again by navigating to the Miami-Dade portal, selecting the Intel® Study icon, and waiting for the application to open again. It should now be much faster since the initial sign in process has already completed.
